These tools make it easy to publish quality digital books using the Blurb book service.

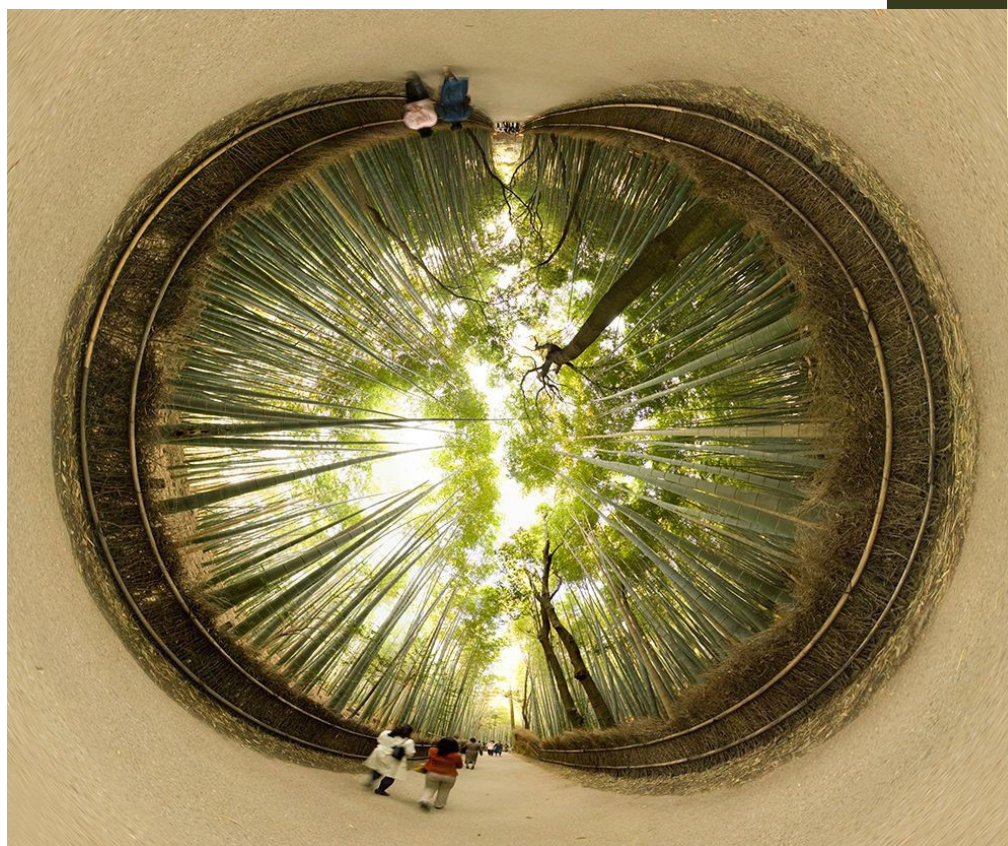
